Y. ROBITAILLE (CHU Ste-Justine, Montreal, Quebec, University of Montreal)

This 52 yo man was admitted at a peripheral hospital for myalgias associated with a lump-like lesion of approximately 3 weeks duration within the left mesial vastus muscle. The lump was tender to palpation. WBC's were raised to 11,000. CK's were slightly elevated.

There was no fever or history of trauma. He was sent to the OR for debridement.
