CASE No 2

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This 83-year-old male with a history of multiple medical problems including a stroke presented with new, progressive, left sided weakness, confusion and headaches. A CT scan of the brain showed a 3 cm mass in the right parietal region with associated edema. CT scans of the thorax and abdomen were normal. Gross total excision of brain tumor was performed.
