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This boy initially presented at the age of 3 with seizures, global developmental delay and unsteady gait. He had progressive deterioration and developed spastic quadriparesis, complete blindness, and refractory epilepsy prior to his death at age 8. Serial imaging documented progressive cerebellar atrophy and abnormal periventricular hyperintensities.
