The neuropathology service includes active participation in a busy multidisciplinary neuro-oncology program, evaluation of autopsy neuropathology and interpretation of muscle/nerve biopsy specimens.

In addition to the above mentioned responsibilities, this role will also include participation in clinical service responsibilities and sign out of either general surgical pathology cases or second subspecialty area. Post training experience is a plus. Additional responsibilities include but are not limited to: participation in multidisciplinary conference presentations and collaboration with ongoing institutional clinical and translational research projects.
