Good Afternoon,

I am writing to ask for your help in identifying candidates for a Neuropathology faculty position at the Lewis Katz School of Medicine at Temple University. The selected candidate may also serve as the Director of Autopsy Service.

The Department of Pathology performs over 120 autopsies and receives over 16,500 surgical specimens, (excluding nearly 10,000 oral pathology specimens), 3000 cytology specimens, 100 autopsies, and performs over 1.6 million laboratory tests in a typical year. The faculty includes 16 MDs and 12 PhDs. The Anatomic Pathology faculty (13) includes four Board Certified Cytopathologists, two Board Certified Hematopathologist and nephropathologists; there are also GYN/breast pathologists and a GI pathologist. There is also an extremely busy oral pathology service staffed by two experienced oral pathologists.

Neurosciences are rapidly expanding area at Temple (Department Neuroscience and Shriner's Center for Neural Repair and Rehabilitation) and the Department of Neurosurgery produces approximately 90 surgical pathology specimens of which the majority is tumors.

Ample opportunities for collaborations also exist for an academically inclined neuropathologist.

Salary and rank will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.
