Candidates must have a record of independent research funding or demonstrate a strong potential for development of such program. The appointment may be of any rank and depends on the qualifications of the candidate.

Areas of special interest are in neuroinflammation, neuro-oncology, neurovascular biology, stroke, glial biology, and drug delivery into the central nervous system. The research environment is interdisciplinary and highly collaborative. Attractive new modern laboratory space, including a new BSL-3 facility, is available for the successful candidates. Board certification in Anatomic and/or Clinical Pathology, and eligibility for unrestricted medical license in Pennsylvania are required.
