



NEUROPATHOLOGY FACULTY POSITION



The Division of Neuropathology in the Department of Pathology at Vanderbilt University Medical Center in Nashville, TN invites applications for a full-time, board certified/board eligible, Academic Neuropathologist at the level of Assistant or Associate Professor. Applicants should have M.D. or M.D./Ph.D. degree(s) and be qualified for appointment to a faculty position and licensure in the state of Tennessee. Candidates should have a record of scientific productivity and demonstrated potential for the development of a vigorous independent or collaborative research program in basic, clinical or translational science. Clinical duties will comprise shared diagnostic responsibilities for neurosurgical and autopsy neuropathology. Teaching activities will include participation in the Neuropathology Fellowship Program and Anatomic Pathology Residency Program. Vanderbilt University Medical School is among the top 10 U.S. medical schools for NIH funding. *U.S. News and World Report* listed Vanderbilt Medical Center on its 2009 "Honor Roll" of hospitals. Vanderbilt-Ingram Cancer Center has been one of a select few National Cancer Institute-designated cancer centers since 1995 and one of only 40 achieving the NCI's highest distinction, as a Comprehensive Cancer Center, since 2001. Nashville is a growing cosmopolitan area with a population exceeding 1 million, diverse entertainment, excellent schools, and ready access to outdoor activities.
