Applicants must have an M.D. or M.D./Ph.D. or equivalent degree and have demonstrated excellent qualifications in Clinical Care, Education, and Research. American Board of Pathology certification in Anatomic Pathology/Neuropathology and eligibility for an unrestricted PA medical license are required.

Teaching and mentoring of medical students, pathology residents and fellows will be an integral component of the position. The successful candidate will be expected to conduct and further develop an active research program and to generate extramural funding.
