

Academic Neuropathologist

The Department of Pathology and Laboratory Medicine at the University of Pennsylvania's School of Medicine seeks candidates for an Assistant Professor position in the tenure track. The successful applicant will have experience in the field of Neuropathology with a focus on cellular/molecular studies in neoplasia or neurodegeneration with emphasis in mechanisms of regulation of gene expression. Responsibilities include participation in neuropathology sign-out and attending rotation on the neuropathology service. Applicants must have an M.D. or M.D./Ph.D. or equivalent degree and have demonstrated excellent qualifications in Clinical Care, Education, and Research. American Board of Pathology certification in Anatomic Pathology/Neuropathology and eligibility for an unrestricted PA medical license are required.

Teaching and mentoring of medical students, pathology residents and fellows will be an integral component of the position. The successful candidate will be expected to conduct and further develop an active research program and to generate extramural funding.
